Directions to the Show Site

From Minnesota: From either north or south take the Highway 2 (Bong Memorial Bridge) exit 253A and head east into Superior, Wisconsin. Go through the roundabout to Tower Avenue (2nd set of lights) and take a right onto Tower. Head south past Walmart and Menards and get into left lane by this point. Take a left at 46th on the north end of the fairgrounds and go to the first open entrance on the right into the fairgrounds.

From Wisconsin (coming up Wisconsin 53 or across Highway 2): Highway 53 merges with Highway 2 about 11 miles south/east of Superior. Continue into Superior heading north. After the lights at 18th street get into the left lane and continue north until you reach Belknap Street/Highway 2 (Bong Museum and Barkers Island will be on your right). Turn left on Belknap and stay in the left lane. Continue heading east until you get to Tower Avenue. Take a left onto Tower Avenue and stay in the left lane. Head south past Walmart and Menards until you reach 46th Street (north end of the fairgrounds) and take a left onto 46th and go to the first open entrance and turn right into the fairgrounds.

From Wisconsin (coming up Wisconsin 35):

As you enter the city you will pass through the Village of Superior on 35 first. Then after an opening you will see the fairgrounds on your right. 35 is the same as Tower Avenue here. Turn right on 46th street on the north end of the fairgrounds and go to the first open entrance and turn right into the fairgrounds.

There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex. Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

Note: *Winners from Veteran Classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed competition. If a dog is entered in both Veteran Class and Best of Breed and is defeated in Veterans, the dog CANNOT be shown in Best of Breed.*

REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

The GTCFTC Sweepstakes is open to all Fox Terriers, Smooths & Wires, and must be shown by the owner, breeder or an amateur. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes **DO NOT have to be entered in one of the regular classes**. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches in each breed.

Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos • Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos

All Veteran Fox Terriers are welcome, Smooths & Wires, coats may be **Stripped or Clipped**. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Fox Terriers 7 years of age & older on the day of the show. Dogs may be spayed or neutered. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes **DO NOT have to be entered in one of the regular classes**. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition (Each Day)

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B matches at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.

- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

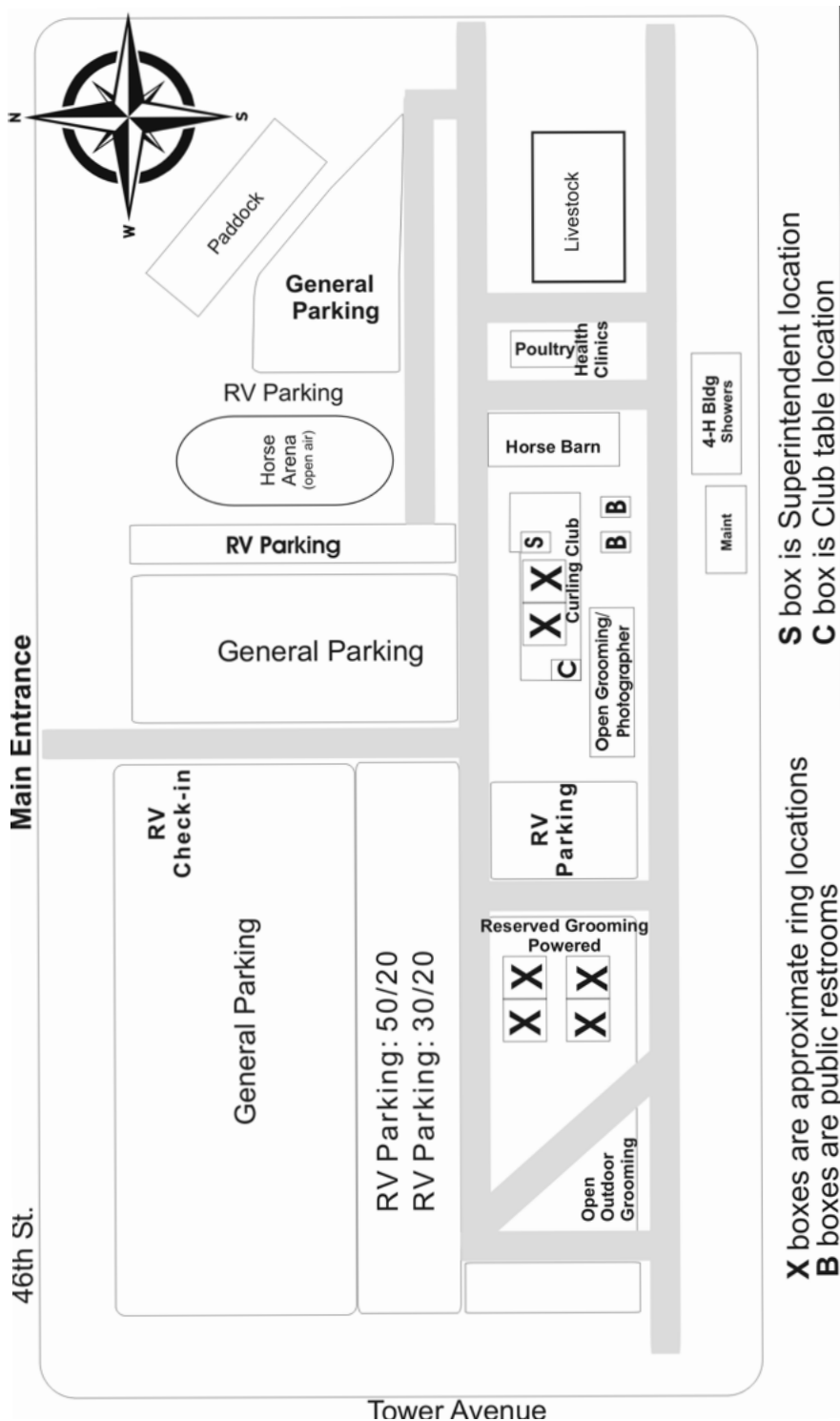

- »The show site will be open to RV's as early as Monday September 14th at 12pm. RV Parking is reserved. Please see the RV/Parking page for more info.
- »RV's on the asphalt side of the rings are not permitted to leave during show hours per AKC show site rules.
- »**Reserved grooming in the curling club and reserved grooming outdoors** will open no earlier than **3pm, Wednesday Sept 16th** for load in, unless otherwise stated by the show staff.
- »There is no parking on the diagonal access road in front of the outdoor open grooming area. You may unload from the access road Wednesday, and each day prior to the start of the show, but you must park on the outside of the fence line during show hours. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** There is also **no parking on the gravel access road next to reserved ringside outdoor grooming.** This is for unloading and loading only before and after show hours. This road will be closed to traffic during show hours per AKC dog show regulations.
- »The curling club will open at 6am each morning and is locked at 10pm each night. No night security will be onsite, but we do have cluster member on the grounds. Dogs may be left in the building overnight. HOLKC and LMKC are not responsible for any dogs and equipment left overnight.

- »**We will be able to determine if the event will need to be moved inside, based on weather conditions, on a day to day basis.** If we need to move inside, the map for rings will change, and is more spread out, so please pay attention. Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
