Miscellaneous Breeds

There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex.

Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

One combined class will be offered for puppies in each breed that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. **There will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy.**

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries in this competition. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.





COURSING ABILITY TESTS
Friday, April 17, 2026 & Saturday, April 18, 2026

NWAKC is excited to share another titling opportunity with our exhibitors. We will be offering two tests on Friday and one test Saturday afternoon, with two different judges, so that dogs can earn their CA title in a single weekend. The purpose of the AKC Coursing Ability Test is to provide all dogs and their owners with an enjoyable, healthy activity in which they can participate. Based on the sport of lure coursing, Coursing Ability Tests will serve as an introduction to the sport for all eligible dog owners. This sport is open to all AKC registered dogs, including Canine Partners.

Dogs run singularly (that is, they run alone, and only one time in each event). They chase a lure made of plastic strips through a series of pulleys. The Coursing Ability Test is a pass-fail event. To pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within a set amount of time. The speed and distance of the run required will depend on the size and type of dog.

- Dogs under 12" at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") = approx. 300 yards in 1- 1/2 minutes.
- Dogs over 12" at the withers that are not brachycephalic = approx. 600 yards in 2 minutes.

The maximum time is not meant to be difficult to achieve, but to prevent a dog that "walks" the course from passing.

The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance. If there is a question as to which course a dog should run, the judge will decide.

Titles will be awarded to dogs that pass the CAT the required number of times; these are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title.

- Coursing Ability (CA)- Dog passes the CAT three times under at least two different judges.
- Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA)- Dog passes the CAT ten times.
- Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX)- Dog passes the CAT 25 times.
- After CAX is earned a number will be added for each additional 25 passed courses.

An orange flat ribbon will be given for each qualifying run, and a new title ribbon will be available for dogs who earn a new AKC title at this event.



The show site will be available to exhibitors at 1:00 pm Friday, April 17, 2026 with the only exception being **WORKING club members**. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

New exhibitor briefing on Saturday . Check the Judging Program for time and location.

REMINDER TO ALL SMOKERS: The building is a SMOKE FREE building.

It's April. Rain, from a drizzle up to a monsoon, is likely. Please bring rain gear for you and your dogs. Be aware that the grounds on the west side of the buildings are prone to mild flooding so please choose where you set up your x-pens and crates carefully.

To ensure adequate space for grooming and quartering of dogs, the Club will require all exhibitors to stack crates, limit grooming tables, and comply with any and all limitations as may be imposed by the Building and Grounds Committee or the Superintendent.

No space may be saved by roping off, using mats, or any other means.

Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.

NO SOFT SIDED CRATES.

ABSOLUTELY NO X-PENS OR 3X3 PUPPY PENS inside of the building. X-pens will be allowed on the South end of the grass behind and on the side of the building unless an RV spot has been reserved.

PLEASE NOTE: The grassy area to the west of (behind) Thompson Hall is reserved RV Parking. Please do not park or set up X-pens on the grass in front of the fence. You may pay for RV Parking if you wish to reserve this space for X-pen set-up. X-pens may be set up on the grass on the South end of the building where Free Grooming is located.

Crating outside rings is limited to temporary set ups during judging of your breed. You may set up crates 15 minutes before judging and remove the crates within 15 minutes after judging. Our space is very limited around the rings. Absolutely no permanent set ups ringside.

Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks or toilets is strictly prohibited. No dogs will be allowed in the restrooms. There will be bathing facilities in the beef barn on the north side of the fairgrounds. This is about 100 feet from the rings. Hose hookups available.

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs on the grounds. Supplies will be available for pickup. This will be enforced.

NOTE ABOUT BLOW DRYERS: The buildings where the rings and most of the grooming are located are not equipped to handle the heavy draw on electricity that multiple blow dryers will cause. Using them in the grooming area is likely to trip the circuit breakers. While we will do our best to reset the breakers promptly so that grooming can continue, we ask that exhibitors consider utilizing the beef barn for blow drying. The area is spacious, roofed with open sides, has heavy duty electrical outlets available, and is free. You are welcome to groom in either location, but please be patient if you choose to use blow dryers in the main grooming area.

In accordance with Sections 1 & 2 of AKC's Dealing with Misconduct, the Show Committee reserves the right to retain Event Committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive. The Show Committee will obtain photographic proof of damaged hotel rooms. The exhibitor will be responsible for picking up after their dogs at the motels/hotels. No bathing/ grooming of dogs in motel rooms.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control & restraint over their children on the day of the show. No strollers will be allowed in the show buildings.

- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.
