## Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

### \*Bred By Exhibitor Class Eligibility:

- \* All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- \* The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- \* To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

## Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

**Veteran Dog/Veteran Bitch Class:** Classes for dogs and bitches six (6) years or older

Note: Castrated Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible for Veteran Classes at independent specialties and by virtue of winning the class, may compete for Best of Breed.

**Gait Class:** Following Best of Breed, dogs entered in the Gait class will be judged by the conformation judge. The winner of this competition will exemplify the best Irish Wolfhound gait as described in the Irish Standard of Excellence. Dogs in this class **MUST** be entered in another class at this show.

**Type Class:** Following Best of Breed, dogs entered in the Type class will be judged by the conformation judge. The winner of this competition will exemplify the best Irish Wolfhound Type as described in the Irish Wolfhound Standard of Excellence. Dogs in this class **MUST** be entered in another class at this show.

## Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: Non-Regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class:** Each entry is allowed two to four get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, **must wear armbands**. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood BitchClass."

**Brace Class:** Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs **MUST** be entered in another class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. **An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."**

**Team Class:** Same rules as Brace Class. Substitute "Four" for "Two" and "Team" for "Brace."

### \*\*Points Available for Reserve\*\*

The Northstar Irish Wolfhound Club will award at its Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the Specialty is held.

## Sweepstakes (Saturday only)

Northstar Irish Wolfhound Club Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. All entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in another conformation class and entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry blank, with Sweepstakes marked as an "Additional Class."

### **SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATIONS**

Dogs – 6 Months & Under 9 Months • Dogs – 9 Months & Under 12 Months  
Dogs – 12 Months & Under 15 Months • Dogs – 15 Months & Under 18 Months  
(Same Classes for Bitches)

### **Division of Prize Money**

35% of entry fees will be retained by the club for expenses. The remaining 65% in each class as follows:

First in each Class ..... 30% of entry fees in that class  
Second in each Class ..... 20% of entry fees in that class  
Third in each Class ..... 10% of entry fees in that class  
Fourth in each Class ..... 5% of entry fees in that class

### **BEST PUPPY COMPETITION**

Offered for dogs & bitches entered and exhibited in the puppy classes to compete for Best Puppy In Specialty. Puppies winning Best of Breed or Best of Winners in regular conformation classes are automatically Best Puppy In Specialty.

### **BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION**

Offered for dogs & bitches entered and exhibited in the Bred-By-Exhibitor class to compete for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Specialty.

### **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in the Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of record and dogs according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

### **SELECT DOG / SELECT BITCH**

After Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex are judged, the remaining Champions of Record will stay in the ring. The judge may award Select Dog and/or Select Bitch from among the Champions of Record. The award of Select Dog or Select Bitch is at the sole discretion of the Judge.

For Further Information See Chapter 16, Section 1, Rules Applying to Dog Shows

### **AWARD OF MERIT**

At the Judge's discretion, up to 2 Awards of Merit may be awarded.

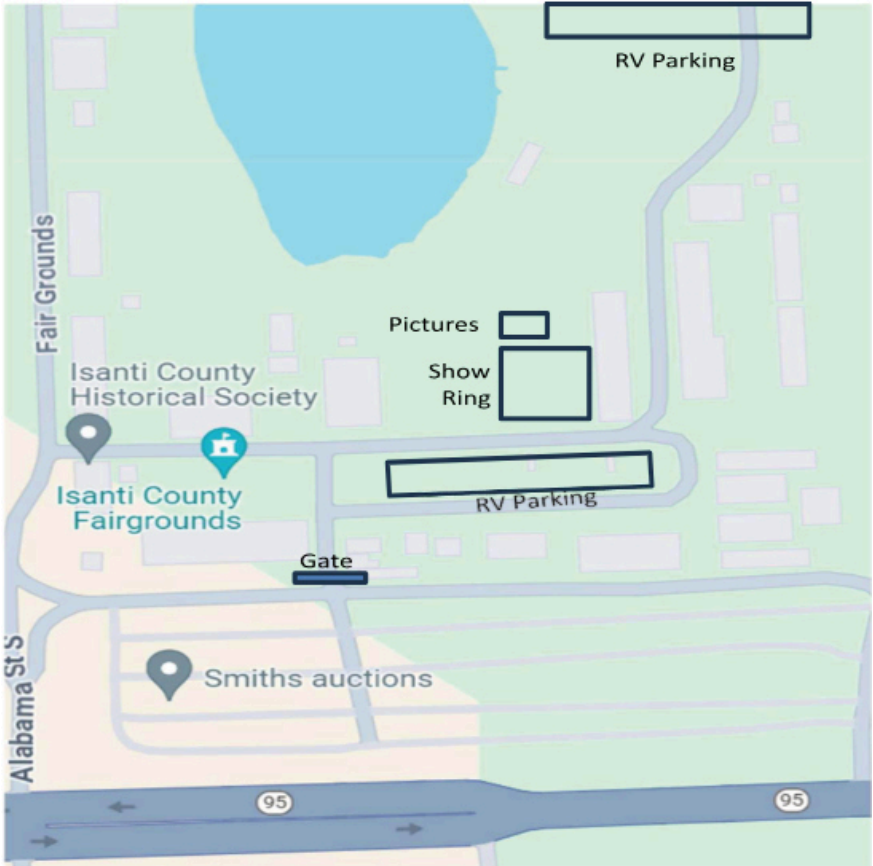

Reservations are not necessary but highly encouraged. When you enter the main chain link gates that bring you into the fairgrounds, the fair office will be on your right. They will collect the camping fees when you arrive. The gate is always open. If the office is closed, please make sure to pay the next day. The showers and bathrooms are close to the show site. The satellite bathrooms will be near the show site.

**Note to Exhibitors:**

- \*Ample Exhibitor Parking next to the show site: level, flat gravel, water and portable toilet location.
- \*The Show Site will be available to Exhibitors after 4 PM, Friday June 12th. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following the close of the show.
- \*Tenting and X Pen set up in designated areas only. No tent/x pen set up within 10 feet of the ring. The area around the ring is large enough for people to set up pop-up tents and x pens.
- \*Rabies and Vaccination Certificate- Minnesota requires proof of current Rabies Vaccination.
- \*Shade is at a minimum. Remember to bring your own pop-ups/ez-ups & shade cloths for the comfort of you and your dog(s).
- \*Do not park in designated Fire Lanes.
- \*You will be able to drive to the show site to drop off tents and pens but you will then have to park in the parking area.
- \* A large pavilion is available and can be used to provide shade while waiting for your classes.
- \* Night time Security will be provided.

Please remember to clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Failure to comply may result in being excused from the show without a refund.

# AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

An AKC Event Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in an event. There is no Event Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions. A \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.**

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
