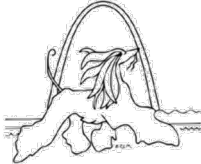

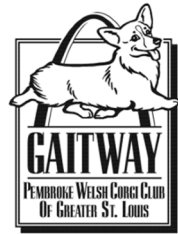

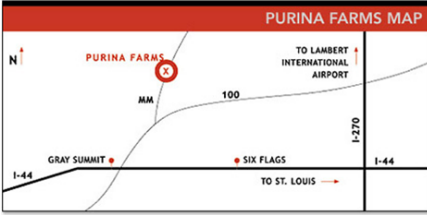

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Vizslas who will be six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show. Puppies in Sweepstakes must be entered in a regular class at the regular fee and on the same entry form under the same event number. Indicate your Sweepstakes class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Professional handlers may only show dogs owned or co-owned by themselves or their immediate family.

REQUIREMENTS

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Vizslas Seven (7) years or older on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes class with the age division in the space provided. Professional handlers may only show dogs owned or co-owned by themselves or their immediate family.

Non Regular (Additional) Classes - Involving Single Dog Entries¹

NOTE: 1st place winners in the following classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed/Variety if undefeated in any other classes at this show.

Veterans Class: A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older. Entries in the Veterans Class may be spayed or neutered.

Hunt Class: A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches who have earned a JH, SH, or MH under AKC Rules Entries in the Hunt Class may **NOT** be spayed or neutered.

Field Class: A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches who have won, placed, or received a Judge's Award of Merit in any AKC licensed or member field trial. Entries in the Field Class may **NOT** be spayed or neutered.

Non Regular (Additional) Classes - Involving Multiple Dog Entries¹

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two, maximum of four, of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition.

The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

¹Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition Gateway Vizsla Club

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- A Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B matches at the option of the show giving club.
- AKC licensed and member clubs sanctioned to hold all-breed conformation dog shows may offer a Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition with any AKC sanctioned companion or performance event. When held with a companion or performance event, classes must be offered for all registerable breeds and varieties and for any breed eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous class and all FSS recordable breeds.
- A Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- A Change to modify an entry to Exhibition Only, or from Exhibition Only to be eligible to compete for awards may not be made after closing.

3. **Vendors** will have access through the loading dock on the south side of the main building at 2pm for set up.
4. Exhibitors seeking setup for **free grooming space** must enter through the North side of the Gateway Hall (main grooming hall). No entry prior to 2pm. 1) One Space Per Person 2) No Saving Space 3) **MUST STACK CRATES**. Electricity will still be on a first-come, first-served basis at no additional charge.
5. **Day of Event Free Crating/ Grooming Space:** Available each day upon opening of building at 6am within the Great Hall (show), no electricity available in this area. Exhibitors are required to stack crates and limit the number of grooming tables within this area.
6. The Cluster Grooming Chair Coordinator, and the applicable Show Committee, reserves the right to consolidate exhibitor's utilization of space within the free grooming area to accommodate as many exhibitors as possible.

There will be a guard on duty in the Purina Event Center on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, & Sunday nights. **Dogs may be left in crates overnight, but each crate must have the name and telephone number of the responsible party for the dog affixed to each crate in case of an overnight emergency** The event center will not be open to exhibitors/owners after 10:00 PM on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights. The Event Center will reopen to exhibitors/owners at **6:00 AM** on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday mornings. Dogs and equipment must be removed from the Purina Event Center immediately following Best in Show on **Monday, June 1, 2026**.

All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. All exhibitors must abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Purina Events Center. **NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO THE BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.** Bathing of dogs inside the Events Center is limited to bathing areas located next to the grooming area in the Gateway Hall. No dogs are allowed in the exhibitors' bathing/restroom areas. There are two bathing/grooming tubs, available 24 hours a day, located in the Services Center Building adjacent to the RV parking area.

RINGSIDE CRATING

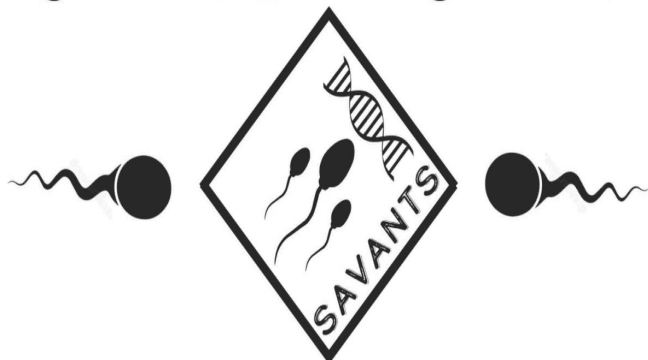
