The above classification is provided for all breeds (and varieties). Additional divisions, (i.e. age, color, or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

The following Non Regular Classes are offered at The Tibetan Terrier Club of America Specialty on June 5, 2026 and Designated Specialty on June 6, 2026.

For the Specialty on June 5, 2026, Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may compete in the Veteran Class

The winner of each of these classes will be **eligible to compete** for Best of Breed

For the Designated Specialty on June 6, 2026, Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may compete in the Veteran Class

The winner of each of these classes will compete for Best Veteran **AFTER** Best of Breed and are **NOT** eligible to compete in Best of Breed

VETERAN DOG AND VETERAN BITCH CLASSES - *(Divided by Age).*

Veteran 7-9 Class is for dogs and bitches, seven (7) years of age or older on the day of the show and less than nine (9) years of age.

Veteran 9-11 Class is for dogs and bitches, nine (9) years of age or older on the day of the show and less than eleven (11) years of age.

Veteran 11-13 Class is for dogs and bitches, eleven (11) years of age or older on the day of the show and less than thirteen (13) years of age.

Veteran 13 and Over Class is for dogs and bitches, thirteen (13) years of age and over.

Dachshunds (all three varieties): *Miniature* — 11 lbs. & under & 12 mos of age or older
 Open - Any eligible Dachshund

Boxers: Brindle; Fawn

Doberman Pinschers: Black; AOAC

Chinese Shar-Pei: Brushcoat, Horsecoat

Chow Chows: Black, Red, AOAC

Australian Shepherds: Black, Blue Merle, Red, Red Merle,

Collies (Rough): Blue Merle; Sable & White; Tri-Color; White

Shetland Sheepdogs: Sable & White; Black (Tri, B-Black); Blue (Blue Merle, Bi-Blue)

Miscellaneous Breeds

*There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex.
Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.*

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs
Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs
Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs
Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

Best Puppy

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos and under 9 mos and the 9 mos and under 12 mos. classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will elect a Best Bred by Exhibitor from the Bred by Exhibitor Puppy and Adult Class winners. This will be done after the Best of breed Competition judging unless the Best Bred by Exhibitor award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Bred by Exhibitor Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred by exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred by Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B matches at the option of the show giving club.
- AKC licensed and member clubs sanctioned to hold all breed conformation dog shows may offer a Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition with any AKC sanctioned companion or performance event. When held with a companion or performance event, classes must be offered for all registerable breeds and varieties and for any breed eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous class and all FSS recordable breeds.
- Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- A change to modify an entry to Exhibition Only or from Exhibition Only to be eligible to compete or awards may not be made after closing.

Best Puppy

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos and under 9 mos and the 9 mos and under 12 mos. classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will elect a Best Bred by Exhibitor from the Bred by Exhibitor Puppy and Adult Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Bred by Exhibitor award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Bred by Exhibitor Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred by exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred by Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Awards of Merit

Will be awarded at the judge's discretion after Best of Breed. Two awards may be awarded if up to 15 specials are entered; four Awards if up to 30 specials are entered; six awards if over 30 are entered. Winners Dog/Bitch and Select Dog/ Bitch are not eligible for a Judge's Award of Merit.
