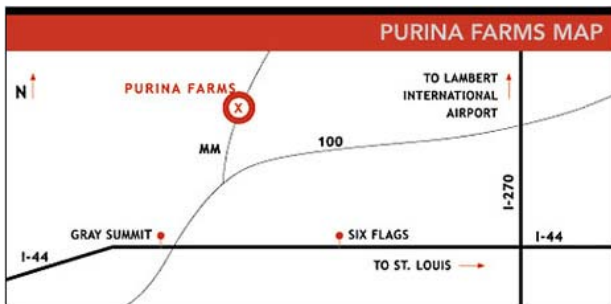

When obedience and rally entries are limited, AKC requires that UDX and RAE classes are listed in the premium. Once the trial’s limit has been reached in either Open B or Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial’s limit has been reached in either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B the RAE class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis will NOT be accepting Rally or Obedience entries for Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, which includes All American/Mixed Breed dogs.

Note: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8, of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males & spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows only.

Veteran 8-10 years: A class for dogs and a class for bitches 8 years & under 10 years on the day of the show.

Veteran 10-12 years: A class for dogs and a class for bitches 10 years & under 12 years on the day of the show.

Veteran 12 years and older: A class for dogs and a class for bitches 12 years or older on the day of the show.

Versatility/Hunter Certificate Class: For Dogs or Bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules or that have earned a Versatility Certificate (VC) or Versatility Excellent Certificate (VCX) under GRCA rules. (Photocopy of VC/VCX Certificate must be attached to entry.)

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box at the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed/Variety competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group if offered.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.

- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.

- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed/Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.

- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.

- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

Rally Ring Size: 40'x60'

In Obedience/Rally Classes requiring jumps, entries MUST include the Dog's Jump Height
In classes with jumps, the judging order will be short to tall jump height (ascending) beginning at
4" on Friday and Sunday; Tall to short (descending) beginning at 26" on Saturday.

Qualifying score required for all prizes

A Dark Green Qualifying Ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a Qualifying Score

"Dog" means either sex

Transfers will be allowed per AKC regulations

PLEASE NOTE: Refund of entry fees (less \$10 per entry) for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after the closing date of these shows may be obtained provided that a veterinarian's certificate and a request in writing is received by the Show Superintendent 30 minutes before the start of regular judging.

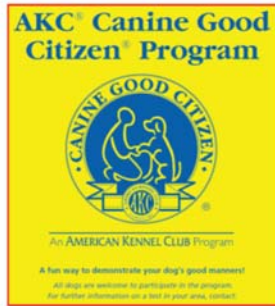

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
