## Grooming

ORKC will offer individual stalls in the barn for private grooming rental. Each day is \$15 per stall. You may bring your own shavings or purchase from ORKC for \$6 a bale. The stalls are 10' x 10' with a mat floor, and include electricity. Stalls may be locked with a padlock. Please bring your own padlock preferably with a long shank. Note that the grooming building is not heated. There is an ample number of stalls available for rental. Stalls will be assigned in order of rental. Shavings and stalls will be available Friday afternoon until 8 p.m. and on Saturday morning until noon. There is an ample number of stalls available so reservations are not needed.

**PLEASE LEAVE STALLS AS YOU FOUND THEM EXCEPT FOR SHAVINGS.**

**A Free Grooming Area is available in the outdoor arena.**

**Grooming is NOT allowed inside of the Arena Building. Use of the arena electricity for grooming equipment and generators are NOT permitted in the Arena Building.**

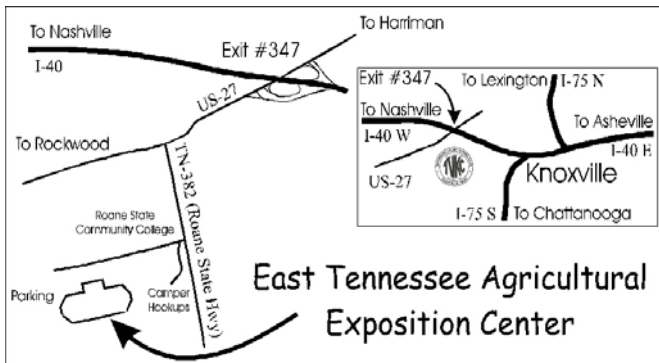
## Routes To The Show

**From Knoxville:** Take I-40 West towards Nashville. Go about 35 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.3 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

**From Nashville:** Take I-40 East towards Knoxville. Go about 130 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Keep LEFT at the fork in the exit ramp. Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.1 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

**From Chattanooga:** Take I-75 North towards Knoxville. Go about 85 miles and take the I-40 West exit (LEFT fork). Go about 20 miles and take the US-27 exit (Exit #347). Turn LEFT onto US-27 and go 2.3 miles. Follow "From US-27" below.

**From US-27:** To TN-382 and Roane State Community College (RSCC). Turn LEFT onto 382 towards RSCC. Go 1.0 miles, passing RSCC on the right, and immediately turn RIGHT towards the Expo Center parking areas. The Expo Center will be on your left. Follow signs to competitor's parking areas on the north and west sides of the building. Do not block driveways on the arena level entrances! **Camper hookups** are on the east side of the building. When you turn RIGHT off TN-382, make an immediate LEFT. Follow signs for camper hookups.



## Arriving At The Show

Note that the East Tennessee Agricultural Exposition Center is a two floor building. There is **NO** elevator between the upper and lower level.

The upper level in the front of the building will contain the Eye Clinic, the Vendors, CGC Testing, Club Information, Meet-The-Breed, Food Service, and Rest Rooms

The Conformation, Obedience and Rally Show Rings are on the lower arena level in the rear of the building.

The Exhibitor Unloading Area is in the rear of the building.

Grooming Stalls are in the barn building behind the Showing Arena.

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.**

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

## USE OF RAMPS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotto Romagnolo, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

## Attention Exhibitors

We would like this event to be a pleasant experience for all in attendance. We ask for your cooperation please in the following areas.

For the convenience of the exhibitors the show grounds (stalls & camper hookups) will be available after 12:00 noon on Friday, January 20, 2017. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The arena and the barn building/grooming area will close 2 hours after Best in Show and will open at 7:00 am each morning.

**There is no charge for exhibitor or spectator parking.**

**There is no admission charge for exhibitors or spectators.**

**No dogs may be left in stalls or exposition center overnight.**

Due to limited space, crates will be allowed ringside only 15 minutes prior and 15 minutes after the breed is judged. This policy will be **strictly enforced**. Grooming area will be located under cover in the outdoor Arena building for no charge or in the Rental stalls located in the barn building behind the Main Arena. NO PARKING in fire lane in front of barn building ONLY. The barn building will be used for reserved grooming, therefore this area MUST be kept clear for loading and unloading. No crates or grooming allowed in Lobby of Exposition Center or in the upper level or on the seating area of the Exposition Center. No grooming in the Main Arena. This will be strictly enforced. Ringside crating is allowed for 15 minutes prior to showing only. Limited day crating for special events is allowed in the arena building in specific designated areas only.

The Arena Building will be locked at 7:00 PM on Saturday and Sunday. The Grooming Barn will be closed at 8:00 PM on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

No dogs may be left in the grooming barn or arena building overnight.

**Dog wash stations will not be available on-site.**

ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE. Vehicles/campers will be allowed to park in designated areas only. Camper parking and/or hookups and grooming stalls available (no camper parking in parking spaces in front of the Exposition Center).
